Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar (EIHP) is a non-profit scientific institution which main activities constitute of scientific research activities, providing professional support to public authorities and advisory services in the domestic and international markets in the field of energy.

The Institute is committed to fostering change in the energy sector by providing high quality services and support to the partners in the field of energy transition. Initially established in 1994, in 2004 the Institute was transformed into a non-profit scientific institution in the state ownership of the Republic of Croatia but is financed on a per project basis through the execution of various project development contracts established through regional and international cooperation in more than 50 countries worldwide.













Today, the Institute has 80 employees and delivers more than 200 projects (studies, elaborations, analyses etc.) per year, with vast experience in Europe and Africa. Areas of EIHP's expertise relevant for the project include cost-optimal analyses for determination of minimal requirements for energy performance of all types of buildings, residential and non-residential, techno-economic analyses of energy efficiency improvement potentials (cost-benefit analyses, feasibility studies, detailed energy audits, investment studies, energy performance certificates), monitoring and verification of energy savings resulting from implementation of energy efficiency projects, preparation of national and local energy efficiency action plans (e.g. NECP, NEEAP, SEAPs) with detailed analyses of potentials and mechanisms for stimulation of energy efficiency measures implementation, preparation of energy efficiency improvement programs for all types of buildings (long term strategy for energy renovation of building stock, energy renovation program for public sector buildings, energy renovation program for single-family houses, program for nZEB, etc.).
